PL 14-37 Honors Scholarship Requirements Deadline: June 30th, 2009

PL 14-37 Honors Scholarship Applicants must provide the following on or before June 30th, 2009
Application and All required documents must be received by the CNMI Scholarship Office on or before June 30th of the year for which the scholarship is to be commenced. (There is only one main application, so applicants may check the PL 14-37 Honors Scholarship box and the EAP box.)

The required documents include, but are not limited to:

- a) Official high school transcript
- b) Letter of acceptance from an U.S. Accredited college or university;
- c) Certified Scholastic Achievement Test (SAT) and/or American College Testing (ACT);
- d) Two letters of recommendation;
- e) A description of extra curricular activities (Must be certified);
- f) Proof of citizenship and residency such as a U.S. passport, parents' CNMI tax forms, CNMI voter registration, or other similar documents deemed acceptable or appropriate to the Scholarship Advisory Board.
- g) Applicants graduating within the CNMI must have attended school within the CNMI for a minimum total of six (6) years. Within the six (6) years requirement, applicants must have attended high school in the CNMI - two (2) years immediately preceding the date of the award (For example, Official transcript from 11th and 12th grade, then any four years of school)**

In addition to the requirements stated above, applicants graduating from a high school within the United States of America or its territories as one of the top students scholastically are eligible to apply, provided the applicant attained the highest scholastic achievement with a 4.0 or higher cumulative grade point average and of parents who are bonafide CNMI resident(s) at the time of application and have been so for a minimum period of eight (8) years prior to the date of application. - ➔ You may pick up the 2009 2010 Memorandum of Agreement/Promissory Note at our office or you may download it from our website.
- ➔ Your check will not be released until we have received all requested documents and your signed and notarized Memorandum of Agreement/Promissory Note.
- ➔ Your status will be posted on our website with only your Social Security No. to identify you. [This information will be updated every week beginning August 17th, 2009.
- ➔ Please remember, it is very important that you update our office of any changes in contact information or academic status.
